

Centering Pregnancy initiative Allowable Costs:

Awardees of the CenteringPregnancy funds may use the financial award for the following allowable costs.

- General guidance:
 - Allowable costs include funding to health providers to improve and expand the use of the CenteringPregnancy model to address racial disparities in preterm birth.
 - Allowable costs should be reasonable; costs should reflect what a prudent person might pay. The cost is allowable if CenteringPregnancy program benefits from it.

Program expenses	Description	Allowable Cost?
Salaries, Wages, and Fringes	For employees working on CenteringPregnancy related work.	Yes
Contractual	Subcontracts necessary to carry out CenteringPregnancy work. For example, advertising services to recruit CenteringPregnancy program participants.	Yes
Supplies and Materials	Costs incurred for materials and supplies necessary to carry out CenteringPregnancy work. For example, non-capitalized equipment such as computers that are < \$5,000.	yes
Travel	Reimbursement for staff attending CenteringPregnancy related training, presentations, and workshops.	Yes
Other costs	For example, meal cost associated with a CenteringPregnancy training	Yes
Indirect costs	For example, office space rental, utilities, office furniture, postage, etc	Yes
Capital expenditure for equipment and facility improvements	Funds used to purchase, upgrade, or extend the life of an asset. For example, building, land, machinery, vehicles, office equipment	No
